Ephesians 6:10-18

Ephesians 6:10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in His mighty power. ¹¹ Put on the full armor of God, so that you are able to stand against the schemes of the devil. ¹² For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, **but against the rulers, against the powers, against the worldly forces of this darkness, and against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places.** ¹³ Therefore, take up the full armor of God, so that you may be able to resist when the times are evil, and after you have done everything, to stand firm. ¹⁴ Stand firm then! Buckle the belt of truth around your waist, and put on the breastplate of righteousness. ¹⁵ Strap up your feet in readiness with the Good News of *shalom*. ¹⁶ Above all, take up the shield of faith with which you will be able to extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. ¹⁷ And take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. ¹⁸ Pray in the *Ruach* on every occasion, with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, keep alert with perseverance and supplication for all the *kedoshim*.

David's Experience

1 Samuel 17:38-39

38 Then Saul clothed David with his own garb, put a bronze helmet on his head, and clothed him in armor. 39 David strapped his sword on his garment and tried to walk, but he was not used to it. So David said to Saul, “I cannot walk in these, for I am not used to them.” So David took them off.

1 Samuel 17:45-47

45 Then David said to the Philistine, “**You are coming to me with a sword, a spear and a javelin, but I am coming to you in the Name of Adonai-Tzva’ot, God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied.** 46 This very day Adonai will deliver you into my hand, and I will strike you down and take your head off you, and I will give the carcasses of the Philistines’ camp today to the birds of the sky and the wild beasts of the earth. Then all the earth will know that there is a God in Israel, 47 **and so all this assembly will know that Adonai delivers not with sword and spear—for the battle belongs to Adonai—and He will give you into our hands.**”

1 Samuel 17:50-51

50 **So David prevailed over the Philistine** with a sling and a stone, struck the Philistine down and killed him. Since there was no sword in David’s hand, 51 David ran, stood over the Philistine, **picked up his sword, drew it from its sheath, slew him** and cut off his head with it. When the Philistines saw that their champion was dead, they fled.

Matthew 26:52

52 Then Yeshua said to him, “Put your sword back in its place! **For all who take up the sword shall perish by the sword.**”



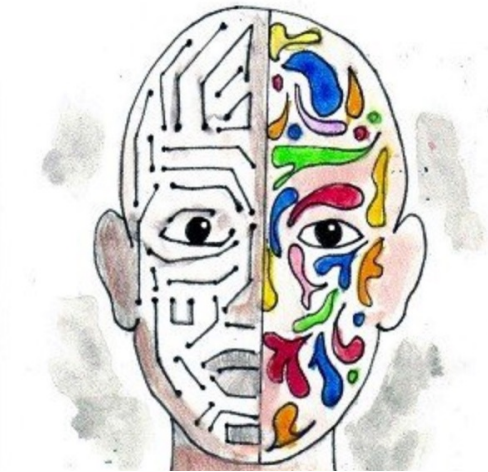
Think Like a Hebrew

Abstract thought is the expression of concepts and ideas in ways that can not be seen, touched, smelled, tasted or heard.

Appearance vs. Functional

Greek thought describes objects in relation to its appearance. Hebrew thought describes objects in relation to its function.

Impersonal vs. Personal

The Greek culture describes objects in relation to the object itself. The Hebrew culture describes objects in relation to the Hebrew himself.

03

Passive vs. Active

Greek nouns are words which refer to a person, place or thing. Hebrew nouns refer to the action of a person place or thing.

Royal Priesthood

1 Peter 2:9-10

9 But you are **a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation**, a people for God's own possession, so that you may proclaim the praises of the One who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light. 10 Once you were "not a people, but now you are "God's people." You were shown "no mercy," but now you have been shown "mercy."

Exodus 39:22-23

22 Then Bezalel made the robe of the ephod of woven work, all of blue; 23 there was an opening [for the head] in the middle of the robe, **like the opening in a coat of armor**, with a hem around it, so that it would not be frayed or torn. [AMP]

Isaiah 59:17

17 For He [the Lord] **put on righteousness like a coat of armor**, And **salvation [Yeshua] like a helmet on His head**; He put on garments of vengeance for clothing And covered Himself with zeal [and great love for His people] as a cloak. [AMP]





Belt of Truth

Leviticus 8:6-7

6 Moses brought Aaron and his sons and washed them with water. 7 He put the tunic on Aaron, **tied the sash on him**, clothed him with the robe, put the ephod on him, and tied the skillfully decorated sash of the ephod around him and fastened it on him.

Isaiah 11:5

5 Also righteousness will be the **belt around His loins**,
and faithfulness **the belt around His waist**.

Proverbs 3:3-4

3 Let kindness and truth never leave you—
bind them around your neck,
write them on the tablet of your heart.
4 Then you will gain favor and a good name
in the eyes of God and man.



Breastplate of Righteousness

Exodus 28:15

15 “**Make a breastplate of judgment**, the work of a skillful craftsman. You are to make it like the design of the ephod—of gold, blue, purple, scarlet and finely twisted linen.

Exodus 28:29

29 “Aaron will bear the names of Bnei-Yisrael in the **breastplate of judgment on his heart**, whenever he enters the holy place, as a continual memorial before Adonai. 30 Also put the Urim and the Thummim within the breastplate of judgment, so they will be on Aaron’s heart when he goes in before Adonai. Aaron will bear the judgment of Bnei-Yisrael on his heart before Adonai continually.





Feet of Peace

Exodus 3:5

5 Then He said, “Come no closer. **Take your sandals off your feet, for the place where you are standing is holy ground.**”

Joshua 5:15

15 Then the commander of Adonai’s army replied to Joshua, “**Take your sandal off of your foot, for the place where you are standing is holy.**” And Joshua did so.

Leviticus 16:2

2 Adonai said to Moses, “Tell Aaron your brother not to come at just any time **into the Holiest Place behind the curtain** — before the atonement cover which is on the Ark—so that he would not die. For I will be appearing in the cloud over the atonement cover.

Isaiah 52:7

7 **How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of him who brings good news, who announces shalom, who brings good news of happiness,[a] who announces salvation, who says to Zion, “Your God reigns!”**

NOTE: Bare feet are quiet, peaceful.



Shield of Faith

Genesis 15:1

15 After these things the word of Adonai came to Abram in a vision saying, “Do not fear, Abram. **I am your shield**, your very great reward.”

Exodus 13:21

21 **Adonai went before them in a pillar of cloud by day to lead the way and in a pillar of fire by night** to give them light. So they could travel both day and night. 22 The pillar of cloud by day and the pillar of fire by night never departed from the people.

Psalms 3:1-3

2 Adonai, how many are my foes! Many are rising up against me! 3 Many are saying to my soul: “There is no deliverance for him in God.” Selah 4 But **You, Adonai, are a shield around me**, my glory and the lifter of my head.

Proverbs 2:7

7 He stores up sound wisdom for the upright. **He is a shield to those who walk in integrity.**



Helmet of Salvation

Exodus 28:36-38

36 “Also you are to make a plate of pure gold and engrave on it, like the engravings of a seal, ‘HOLY TO Adonai.’ 37 **Attach it with a violet cord onto the turban, on the front of the turban.** 38 **So it will rest on Aaron’s forehead**, so that Aaron will bear away the iniquity committed regarding the holy things, which Bnei-Yisrael set apart as all their holy gifts. **It is to be always on his forehead**, so that they may have favor before Adonai.

Revelation 20:4

4 Then I saw thrones, and people sat upon them—those to whom authority to judge was given. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony for Yeshua and because of the word of God. They had not worshiped the beast or his image, **nor had they received his mark on their forehead** or on their hand. And they came to life and reigned with the Messiah for a thousand years.

Revelation 22:4

4 They shall see His face, and His name shall be **on their foreheads**.



Sword of the Spirit

Hebrews 4:12

12 For **the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword**—piercing right through to a separation of soul and spirit, joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

Isaiah 49:2

2 **He made My mouth like a sharp sword.**

In the shadow of His hand He hid Me.

He made Me a polished arrow,

He has hidden Me in His quiver.

Revelation 1:16

16 In His right hand He held seven stars, and **out of His mouth came forth a sharp, two-edged sword.** His face was like the sun shining at full strength



Pray in the Spirit

Romans 8:26-27

26 In the same way, the Ruach helps in our weakness. For **we do not know how to pray as we should, but the Ruach Himself intercedes for us with groans too deep for words.** 27 And He who searches the hearts[a] knows the mind of the Ruach, because He intercedes for the kedoshim according to the will of God.

Ephesians 6:18

18 **Pray in the Ruach** on every occasion, with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, keep alert with perseverance and supplication for all the kedoshim.

Jude 1:20

20 But you, loved ones, continue building yourselves up on your most holy faith, **praying in the Ruach ha-Kodesh.**

1 Corinthians 14:15

15 What is it then? **I will pray in my spirit, but I will also pray with my mind.** I will sing praises with my spirit, and I will also sing praises with my mind.
